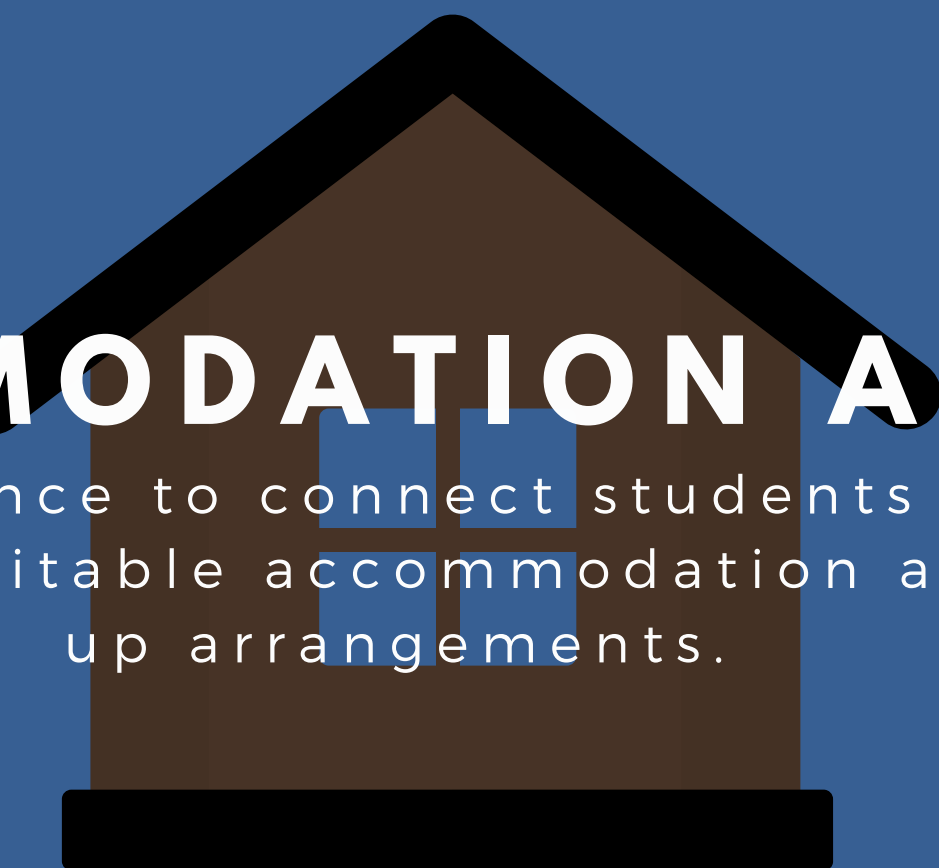
FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SCHEME
